Course One is comprised of four sections. Each section speaks to a different learning outcome. The sections and accompanying outcomes for Course One are:

1. Spiritual Disciplines - *Has implemented practices, rhythms, and a plan for abiding in God (Father, Son and Holy Spirit) during Initial Staff Training.*
2. Holy Spirit - *Is able to communicate how the Holy Spirit is bringing about personal transformation in character, desire, and will, with Biblical conviction.*
3. Sharing the Gospel - *Can share how the Gospel has brought joy and freedom to a place of shame, guilt, brokenness, or suffering in their own life.*
4. Prayerful Faith - *Has exercised prayerful faith, trust and dependence on God through His promises for personal provision and faith initiatives.*

3. Intaking and Obeying the Word of God: *Able to utilize a variety of means to intake and obey the Word of God.*
4. Sharing the Scriptures: *Able to share the Scriptures with others in a variety of ways.*

Participating in Community

Course Three is comprised of four sections. Each section speaks to a different learning outcome. The sections and accompanying outcomes for Course Three are:

1. Healthy Relationships: *Has initiated with new people outside and within the Kingdom, facilitating healthy relationships and community environment.*

2. Disciplemaking Communities: *Has sought to develop communal, transformational, missional, & generational qualities within a disciplemaking community they are influencing.*
3. Biblical Conflict Resolution: *Has acquired and practiced biblical conflict resolution skills.*
4. Interdependence and Community: *Has demonstrated unity and interdependence with other parts of the Navigator work and across the broader Body of Christ.*

Engaging with those who don't know Christ

Core 401 has three sections. Each section speaks to a different learning outcome. The sections and outcomes are:

1. A Plan to Engage: *Has formed and implemented a plan to regularly engage with those who don't know Christ in their natural everyday life (family, friends, neighborhood, work/school, etc.) or in their missional ministry context.*
2. Spiritual Conversations: *Can initiate spiritual conversations and share the good news of the Kingdom.*
3. Sharing the Gospel: *Can skillfully utilize contextual resources for sharing the Gospel.*

Reproducing Spiritual Generations

Course Five is comprised of four sections. Each section speaks to a different learning outcome. The sections and accompanying outcomes for Course Five are:

1. Pioneering Personal Ministry: *Has pioneered personal ministry (individually or with a team) in a new context to lay the foundation of generational ministry.*
2. Follow-Up: *Has personally engaged with or "followed-up" a new Christ follower or young believer with the aim of establishing them as a disciple of Jesus.*
3. Helping Another: *Has demonstrated growing disciplemaking vision, experience, and skill through personally helping another in each of the Five Traits of a Disciplemaker with spiritual generations in mind*
4. Mobile Alongsiders: *Has functioned as a mobile alongsider in equipping, empowering, and encouraging a disciplemaker or local leader.*

Navigator 101

Core 601 has four sections. Each section speaks to a different learning outcome. The sections and outcomes are:

1. Ability to communicate the story of Dawson Trotman and the early and recent history of The Navigators.
2. Familiarity with a number of historical tools used by the Navigators and able to share The Wheel illustration.
3. Understanding of the importance of Scripture memory, the history of the Topical Memory System (TMS), and is able to implement a personal Scripture memory plan.
4. Knowledge and increasing embodiment of The Navigators' Calling, Core Values, Vision, and Statement of Faith.
