ISM Connect Role Description

ISM Connect - a 10-month training program designed for Navigators International Student Ministry alumni and volunteers who can give 5-10 hours/week in growing in knowledge and experience in the areas of evangelism, discipleship, personal growth, and on-campus ministry with the desired outcome of being equipped and sent out in disciple-making.

Participant Commitment

- 5 to 10 total hours/week for 10 months
- Growing relationship w/Jesus and be Faithful, Available, Initiator, Teachable, Humble (FAITH)
- Regular meetings with assigned local campus trainer
- Availability to meet regularly with campus team and ISM Connect cohort
- Completion of training assignments and frequent communication if adjustments are needed.
- Maintain excellence at work, studies, and/or OPT/CPT.
- Exemplify the Navigator Statement of Faith and grow in Navigator Core Values

Local Team and Trainer's Commitment

- Team (1-2hrs) and Trainer (3-5hrs) schedules that reflect weekly time to train ISM Connect
- Leading, Development, and Care contributing towards wholistic discipleship of participant
- Regular meetings with participant to teach, model, and coach disciple-making
- Team meetings and events allow for integrated participation among staff and ISM Connect
- Trainers provide robust materials and curriculum and use DRESSCODES for assessment

EVANGELISM (Making Christ known through intentional and loving engagement with the lost)

- Use your testimony to share Christ with others
- Learn and use a reproducible and culturally appropriate tool for sharing Christ with others
- Teach, model, and coach students and volunteers how to share their faith

DISCIPLESHIP (Establishing and equipping believers to become Christ-followers and laborers)

- Receive relational discipleship from a Navigator representative and disciple a young Christfollower with the goals of establishing believers and equipping laborers
- Grow as a disciple and disciple-maker by learning and utilizing tools such as the Topical Memory System (TMS), the Wheel, and Bridge illustrations to help others follow Jesus
- Learn and practice building biblical convictions and apply those convictions when navigating relationships, work, neighbors, and faith communities.
- Teach, model, and coach other students and volunteers in how to disciple a young believer

GROWTH (Growing in Christ-like character, emotional, spiritual, and physical health/ministry)

- Sharpen and broaden spiritual disciplines that cultivate a vibrant walk with Jesus, ministry, and emotionally healthy Christ-following.
- Gain a better understanding of how God designed you through coaching in personality, strengths, and contribution assessments.
- Study, discover, and apply God's personal and general calling when determining future plans, jobs, and careers.
- Teach, model, and coach other students and volunteers in glorifying God by living out God's plan and purposes for their lives.

EXPERIENCE (Connecting w/international students, a team, and a local church for ministry)

- Lead an Investigative Bible Discussion
- Participate in and contribute to a disciple-making community.
- Develop partnership with local believers and churches that allow for training volunteers in disciple-making, but also in receiving care.
- Learn principles and begin developing a team of ministry partners for prayer, encouragement, and support
