

Proposed Focus Ministry Training for ISM Edge and SiT

Edge (5 hours)

- 2 hrs - read *A Muslim's Heart* by Edward Hoskins
 - What did you come across in the book that was unique to evangelism among Focus people?
 - Was there anything you didn't understand? Make a list of the questions you have.
- 3 hrs - book discussion and ISM-specific training on Zoom with Focus Network leadership team (2 x 90 min)
- Optional reading:
 - *Cross and Crescent: Responding to the Challenges of Islam*, 2nd Edition, by Colin Chapman
 - *Miniskirts, Mothers & Muslims: A Christian Woman in a Muslim Land*, 2nd Edition, by Christine Mallouhi

Staff in Training (8+ hours)

- 5 hours – same as Edge training, but the SiT Zoom sessions will be done separately from the Edge sessions.
- Practical assignment on local campus, for example:
 - Research: How many Focus students are there on your campus? What are the two largest populations/sending countries?
 - Interaction: Engage in a conversation with a Focus student.
- 1-hour Zoom discussion after completion of assignment – How did it go? What did you learn?
- Additional Zoom session – biblical basis for Focus ministry or discussion of book excerpts (TBD)
